ABOUT THE WOMEN IN CYBER AWARDS

Launched by GCF, with the support of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and UN Women, the Women in Cyber Awards recognize organizations that have measurably advanced women’s participation, leadership, and impact in cybersecurity over the past two years.

The Awards are part of the Women Empowerment in Cybersecurity (WEC) global initiative, instated by H.R.H. Prince Mohammed bin Salman, Crown Prince and Prime Minister of Saudi Arabia, and implemented by GCF to strengthen global cyber resilience by contributing to efforts to increase women’s participation and close the talent gap.

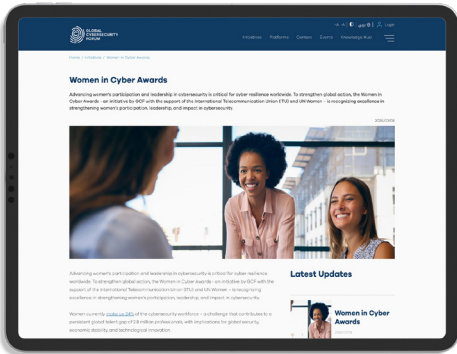

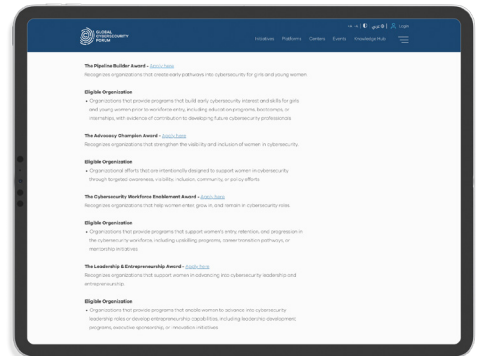

Review the award tracks

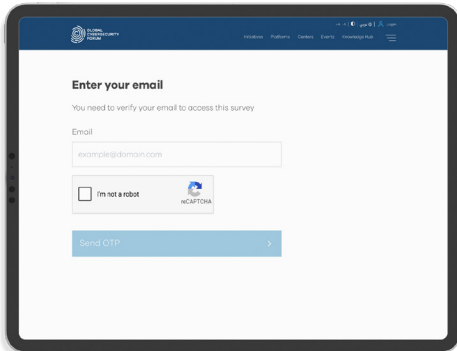
Scroll down to review the award track criteria and identify which best reflects your organization's work and impact. You may apply under the track that most closely aligns with your organization's contribution.

After clicking to apply, you will be asked to enter your email address and complete the verification step using the code sent to your inbox.

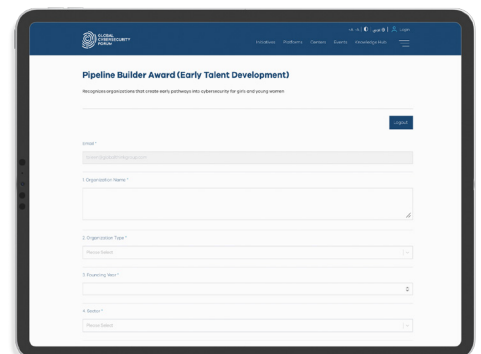

Complete and submit your application form

Fill in the online application form, including relevant organizational, program, and impact information, and submit it through the awards platform.

You may save your application as a draft and return to it later if you need additional time to gather the required information. Once submitted, you will receive an email confirming that your application has been received.

A jury committee of senior representatives from GCF, ITU, and UN Women as well as independent experts will review the top candidates, conduct interviews, rank candidates, and make the final winner decisions.
